Personal visit *Weekdays*

We encourage parents to book a personal visits. Personal visits are available on weekdays. They provide an opportunity to see the school on a working day; you can pop in and out of lessons, talk to current pupils and staff and even have a look at what is on the lunch menu for the day. Visits include a one-to-one meeting with a member of the Senior Management Team.



Assessment Day *Autumn term of Year 2*

Year 3 assessments are held during the Autumn term of Year 2. Children are invited to spend some time with current Year 2 pupils for a taster morning followed by a small number of entry tests after lunch. These tests consist of Maths, English and reasoning tests.
