Personal visit Weekdays	Personal visits are available on weekdays. Registration By end of Novembe of Year 6	Register your application with Hurst by completing the online Registration Form at <u>hppc.co.uk/registration-form</u> . You will also be required to pay a registration fee. This can be done online at <u>https://epay.hppc.co.uk/registration</u>
ISEB online pre-te By Mid-December	There have been some changes to this process and it is important to note that parents are now required to register their children for the ISEB online pre tests. This process starts in September. Assessment Day Early February of Year 6	All registered pupils who have completed the ISEB online pre test will be invited to an assessment day at Hurst where they will participate in a carousel of activities, complete a 20 minute creative writing task and have an informal group interview.
