# **UNIFORM - GENERAL INFORMATION**

All pupils can choose between the trouser uniform or kilt uniform but it must be worn in its entirety.

### Uniform

A full list of uniform requirements can be found over the page. All uniform, with the exception of shoes, can be purchased from the Stevensons College Uniform Shop which is located on the College campus.

#### Personal appearance

Pupils are expected to take pride in their appearance and we appreciate your support in ensuring that your son/daughter looks smart.

#### Hair

Hair should be tidy. Extreme hairstyles, including hair dye, 'tram-lines', use of gel or similar, and variations in hair length (e.g. a mullet), are not permitted.

Girls' hair should be tied back so it is off the face. Hair bands/ties should be navy blue. Boys' hair should be off the collar.

## Jewellery

Girls may wear one pair of earrings - with an earring in each ear lobe.

They may wear one simple metal bracelet (no beads/leather bands/thread), one small metal ring, and one simple metal necklace (no beads).

Any other jewellery worn, including anklets, will be confiscated until the end of the half term.

### Makeup

Makeup is not permitted.

# Shoes

Shoes should be sensible, allowing children to run and play actively at breaktime, but not trainers.

#### Named clothing

All items, including footwear, must be CLEARLY MARKED with your child's NAME by a name label or laundry marker. Please ensure all such labels are sewn FLAT and not just on the ends.

Senior Prep School regulation PE and games kit purchased from the Uniform Shop should be embroidered with your child's initials. An embroidery service is available from the Uniform Shop for a nominal charge.

#### Lost property

We aim to return lost items to their owners swiftly, although if items they are unnamed this may prove difficult.

At some stage your child may come home with an item of uniform that doesn't belong to him/her. We would be grateful if you would make sure it is returned to the owner directly or to the school office.

Unclaimed lost property is laid out in the foyer at the end of term. Unnamed items will be given to charity if unclaimed.

#### PERSONAL POSSESSIONS

In the Senior Prep School, pupils should have a fully-equipped and named pencil case containing the following items:

- HB pencil
- Eraser
- Enclosed pencil sharpener
- 30 cm ruler
- Pair of compasses
- Protractor
- Set of colouring pencils (in a named pencil case)
- Safe pair of scissors
- Glue stick

Please do not allow your child to bring Tipp-ex or spray deodorants into school. We also recommend that pupils in Years 7 and 8 have their own medium-sized French and Spanish dictionary.

All pupils in Year 7 and above will require a CASIO FX-991CW scientific calculator. Please ensure that calculators are named by engraving or by using an indelible marker.

All watches must be named with the owner's name or initials.

Cameras, iPods and other valuable items of equipment should not be brought into school or taken on day trips as the school cannot accept any responsibility for their safety.

Musical instruments are an exception.

Pupils may bring mobile phones to school, but they must be handed to their tutor on arrival and collected at the end of the school day.

Borrowing other pupils' kit without permission is not allowed and will be regarded as stealing.

The on-site shop is located on Chalker's Lane, next to the Dance and Drama studios (opposite the Senior Prep School). There are reserved parking spaces for customers.

#### Second hand Uniform Shop

The Hurst Foundation runs a Second Hand Uniform Shop to raise funds which will directly benefit the pupils. The shop is located behind the main uniform shop – take the path that runs to the right-hand side of the main uniform shop (through the gate), then turn left through the green gates and the shop is on the right.

Please note, due to the Prep School uniform changes in September 2023 we are no longer accepting any uniform items which are not listed in this guide (Senior Prep 2023/24) or in the Junior Prep School uniform guide for 2023/24

Everything should be clearly labelled with the seller's name and address. A telephone number and bank details should be put in a sealed envelope so payment can be made via BACS. 50% of the proceeds go to the seller and 50% to the Hurst Foundation funds.

# TROUSER UNIFORM





Ties must be done up with a flat-fronted knot (i.e. a Windsor knot). House tie colours are outlined at the end of this booklet.

The following shoes are not acceptable: canvas plimsolls, thick crepe soles, 'deck' shoes, boots, leather trainers (including black leather versions of Nike/Adidas/Vans trainers).

Coats/raincoats/overcoats in a single dark colour may be worn over the school blazer as students are walking round the campus but not in Chapel or during lessons. Coats must be longer than the school blazer, and without adornment (i.e. no fur lined hoods).

All items marked \* must be obtained from the College Uniform Shop.

Our recommendation for the number of items each student will need is shown in brackets.

- Shirt, white, long sleeve, polyester/ cotton with stiff collar (5/9 for boarders)
- Shirt, white, short sleeve, polyester/ cotton with stiff collar (for summer term) (optional)
- 3. Trousers, charcoal\* (must be ankle length and not skin tight) (2)
- 4. Belt, plain black with a plain, discreet buckle (braces are not allowed) (1)

- 5. School tie, maroon with Hurst crest\* (1)
- 6. Pullover, v-neck, navy with silver Hurst eagle\* (1)
- 7. School blazer, navy\* (1)
- 8. Socks, dark grey (5 pairs)
- Shoes, black, strong leather/leather-look
   (2 pairs)
- Coat, plain, dark colour (no fur lined hoods) (optional) (1)
- School scarf, navy with a white and red stripe\* (optional) (1)

#### Standard uniform

Blouses must have a revere collar and not a button-down collar.

School skirts are no longer the wrap-around style. These are no longer acceptable as uniform.

Shoes must not exceed 5cm in height, for safety reasons. Platform or stiletto heels are not allowed (i.e. the heel base must be at least 2cm squared). The following shoes are not acceptable: canvas plimsolls, thick crepe soles, 'deck' shoes, boots, leather trainers (including black leather versions of Nike/ Adidas/Vans trainers). 'Ballet pumps' should be avoided as they provide little support to the foot.

Coats/raincoats/overcoats in a single dark colour may be worn over the school blazer as students are walking round the campus but not in Chapel or during lessons. Coats must be longer than the school blazer, and without adornment (i.e. no fur lined hoods).

All items marked \* must be obtained from the College Uniform Shop.

Our recommendation for the number of items each student will need is shown in brackets.

- Blouse, white, long sleeve with revere collar (for winter) (5)
- Blouse, white, short sleeve with revere collar (for summer) (optional)
- 3. Skirt, tartan\* (1-2)

- Pullover, v-neck, navy with silver Hurst eagle\* (1)
- 5. School blazer, navy with white eagle\* (1)
- Tights, plain black/navy/flesh coloured (no patterns/seam) (5)
- 7. Socks, ankle length or long, white (alternative to tights) (5)
- Shoes, black, leather/leather-look, plain/ unadorned, 5cm max. heel height (1 pair)
- 9. Coat, plain, dark colour (no fur lined hoods) (optional) (1)
- School scarf, navy with a white and red stripe\* (optional) (1)


