By Road

If you are coming to us by road from the **north** from the M25, join the M23 and then the A23 heading south, exit at the Burgess Hill/Hickstead turn-off, turning left at the roundabout to join the A2300. Turn right at the next roundabout (road signposted to Goddards Green and Hurstpierpoint) and go straight over the next junction next to the Sportsman Pub to join Cuckfield Road. After approximately 1.5 miles, turn left onto Chalkers Lane. The Prep School entrance will be approximately 0.5 miles on your right. To get to the Senior School, please continue to the T-junction at the end of Chalkers Lane and turn right into College Lane and then right into the Senior School entrance.

If you are coming to us by road from the **south** join the A23 from Brighton and exit at the Hurstpierpoint turn off to join the B2117. At the end of the slip road turn right onto the B2117. At the roadabout in the village go straight across (second exit) into Cuckfield Road. After approximately 1 mile, turn right into Chalkers Lane. The Prep School entrance will be approximately 0.5 miles on your right. To get to the Senior School, please continue to the T-junction at the end of Chalkers Lane and turn right into College Lane and then right into the Senior School entrance. We recommend not using College Lane as it is narrow.

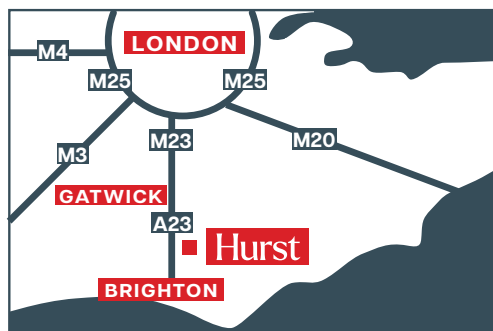
Please note a 5mph speed limit is in operation on all Hurst property. We politely request that all visitors park in a marked parking bay.

By Rail

If you are coming to us by rail, we recommend travelling to Hassocks Station, located at approximately a 10 minute drive from the school. Taxi's are not readily available however, we can recommend South Down Taxis on 01273 846 666. Alternative train stations are Burgess Hill and Haywards Heath.

By Air

If you are coming to us by air, Hurst can be reached quickly from both London Gatwick and London Heathrow airports.



On Arrival

Visitors should vacate the building/area using the nearest available exit making their way to the nearest Fire Assembly Point and remain at that point until otherwise instructed.

Accidents

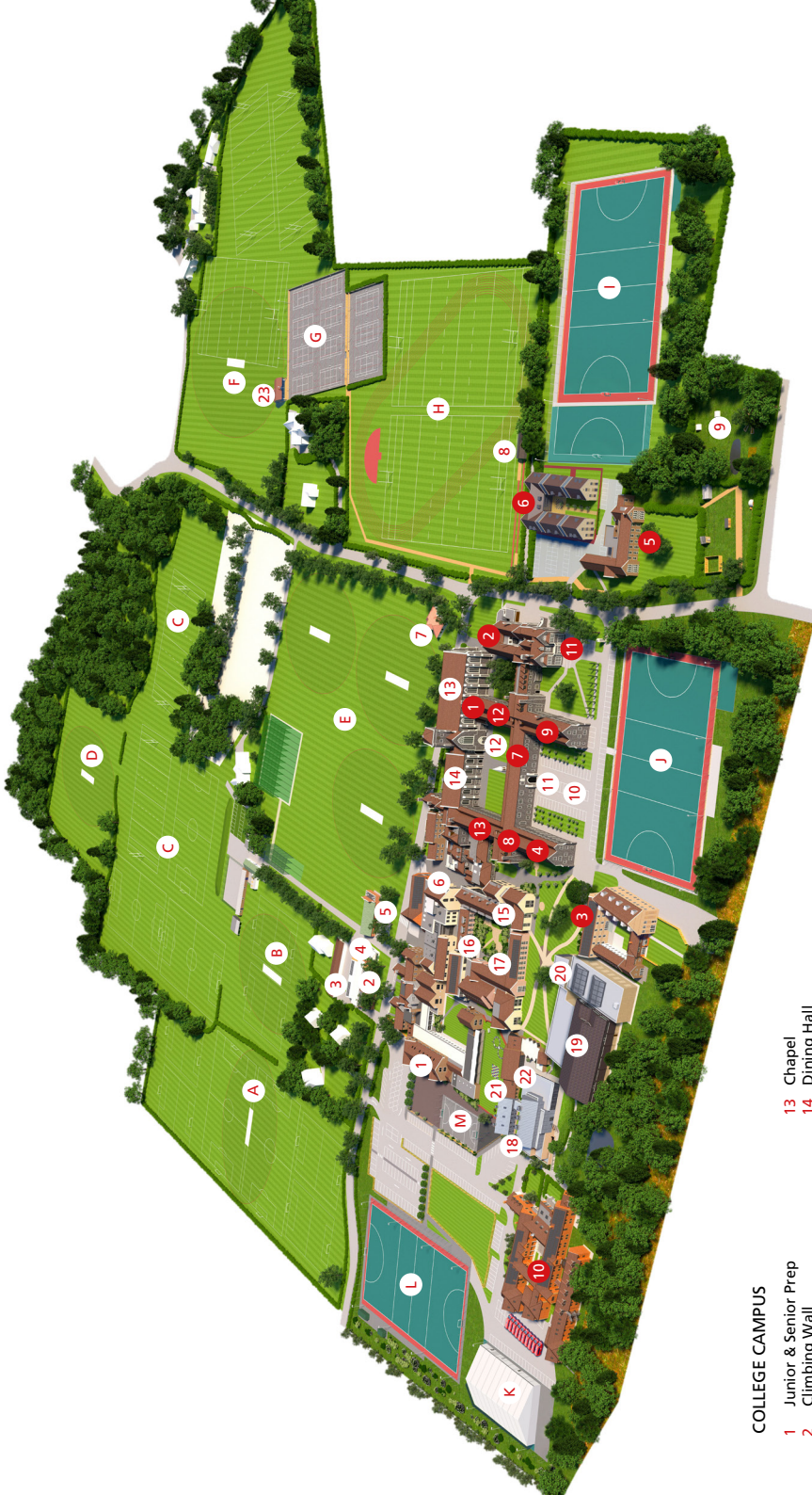
In the event of an accident, incident, illness or near miss, please report this to your host and/or Reception immediately so that the appropriate action can be taken.
