Uniform Rules

Year 7 to Fifth Form

Shoes

Flat heel

Socks and Tights

Tights need to be plain black/navy/ flesh coloured with no patterns or seam.
Socks need to be ankle length or knee length in black or white as an alternative to tights.
House badges
Badges will be provided for all students when they join Hurst.
Personal appearance
Pupils are expected to take pride in their appearance and we appreciate parents’ support in ensuring they look smart.
Hair
The following rules apply to all pupils:
Hair must be brushed and tidy
Hair should not be so long that it falls over the face. In particular, it must not obscure the eyes
Long hair which falls below the shoulder must be tied up neatly (Years 7 and 8 only)
Braided hair must not be adorned with coloured threads or beads
With the exception of medical reasons, hair must not be shorter than a grade 2 cut (ie. more hair should be seen than skin). Any marked differences in length should be blended so that it is not noticeable

Extreme haircuts or overtly/ aggressively coloured/dyed hair is not permitted
Facial hair is not permitted
No pupil is allowed to cut another student’s hair, unless under the direct supervision of their HoM.
The Deputy Head of College, Deputy Head Pastoral and the Senior Mistress are the arbiters of what is reasonable and acceptable.
As a consequence of breaking these rules, the pupil may be sent home immediately. The student will return once their appearance is deemed to be acceptable and in line with College rules.

Jewellery

Pupils may wear:
Earrings – one pair, with an earring in each ear lobe
Bracelet – one simple metal bracelet. No beads, leather bands or thread are allowed
A ring – one small metal ring
A necklace – one simple metal necklace. No beads are allowed
Any other jewellery that is worn, including anklets, will be confiscated until the end of the half term.

Makeup

Pupils in Shell and Remove should not wear makeup or nail varnish.
Pupils in Fifth Form may wear:
Foundation – as a light covering
Lip gloss – colourless
Nail varnish – clear in colour

Additional Sixth Form uniform rules

Below are additional points to help guide Sixth Form students on what is acceptable to wear at College.
Suits
The top and bottom must be matching in fabric and colour
Fabric can be plain, pinstripe, herringbone or tweed
Fabric must not be floral, exotic prints or extreme patterns
Colours should be muted, not bright
Trouser hems must be at least ankle length and not fall below the shoe and trail on the ground
Trousers should be tailored (not appear to be skin tight) and full length
Skirt length must be on the knee
Lycra trousers or skirts are not to be worn – they are too figure-hugging and the skirts do not hold the correct length
Skirts should not have slits or visible zips at the back
Denim must not not be worn
Belts should be co-ordinated and discreet – students must not wear wide belts across their hips
Skirts and trousers tend to be washed more frequently than jackets so fabric can fade as a result and no longer match the jacket. We would therefore recommend either washing both pieces together, or buying two skirts/trousers which match the one jacket, so that students can alternate.
Hair
Sixth Form students may wear their hair down, as long as it is tidy.

Shirts

Must be tailored
Can be any colour but must be in tone with the outfit worn
Patterns can be plain, striped or check
Should be a comfortable fit and must be long enough to ensure that the stomach is not shown
The top button of girls’ shirts must be above the cleavage
Shirts that are not acceptable are: ‘cowboy’ check shirts, brushed cotton/fleecy shirts, denim or vests

Jumpers/Cardigans

Jumpers must be v-neck or quarter zip
Should be a single colour that co-ordinates with the outfit
Must be in a plain knit (rather than a ‘chunky’ knit) as they have to fit comfortably under a suit jacket. Smart cable knit jumpers are also allowed
Cardigans must be button-up and not zip-up
Jumpers and cardigans must not hang down below the suit jacket
Sweatshirts are not allowed

Ties

Ties must be worn at all times, with their top button done up and the knot must be flat-fronted (a Windsor knot)
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Shoes

Shoes must be plain (no patterns), leather (or leather-look) and co-ordinate with the suit
--

The heel must be a maximum height of 5cm and the base of the heel must be at least 2cm squared. Shoes with stiletto heels are not allowed
The following shoes are not acceptable: boots (including ankle boots), canvas shoes, moccasins, ‘deck’ shoes or embroidered/beaded slippers, trainers (including black leather trainers such as those from Nike, Adidas, Vans etc.)

Coats

Raincoats/overcoats in a single dark colour may be worn over suits as students are walking around the campus but not in Chapel or during lessons
Coats must be longer than the suit jacket and be without adornment (no fur lined hoods)

Make up

Students in the Sixth Form may wear subtle make up. They may also wear nail varnish of any colour except black, white, glitter or bright florescent/neon/electric colours. If nail varnish is used, then it must cover the whole nail and not be chipped or ragged.

Other items

Tights must be plain and without seams
Waistcoats may be worn as long as they match the fabric of the suit

Jewellery

Students in the Sixth Form may wear additional rings/bracelets/necklaces, as long as the overall look is discreet and coordinated with the outfit worn. No additional visible body piercings are allowed.



Labelling Clothing

Naming items

- All clothing, including casual clothes and footwear, should be clearly marked with your child's name.
- Sew on labels from the Uniform Shop may take several weeks to be delivered, so please ensure you order well in advance.
- The embossing service is available at the Uniform Shop, but please note that this may take a few days for items to be completed.
- Items should be named as follows:
- Shirts and blouses:
On the inside of the collar
- Vests and T-shirts:
On the inside the of the neck
- Underwear:
On the inside of the back waist (not on the elastic)
- Socks:
Inside, vertically below the elastic
- Towels:
On the corner
- Duvet covers:
On the opening on the outside

The Hurst Foundation runs a Second Hand Uniform Shop to raise funds which will directly benefit the pupils. The shop is located behind the main uniform shop – take the path that runs to the right-hand side of the main uniform shop (through the gate), then turn left through the green gates and the shop is on the right.

Selling/Donating

Current uniform for sale can be brought to the shop when it is open or left at any other time with the Lodge. All uniform should be clean and in good condition.

Everything should be clearly labelled with the seller's name and address. A telephone number and bank details should be put in a sealed envelope so payment can be made via BACS. 50% of the proceeds go to the seller and 50% to the Hurst Foundation funds.

Anything not deemed suitable for sale or unsold after 2 years will be donated to charity.

In the short term, it makes sense to use up as much of the current stock as possible, particularly for families with older children who are coming to the end of their time in the Middle School. Any unsold items will be donated to charity as part of an initiative to ensure that there is zero landfill as a result of this change. It will, of course, take time to build up a stock of second hand items from the new range, but over the course of the year they will begin to acquire items from children who have quickly outgrown their clothes, and I would urge you to make full use of this excellent resource.

Sustainability Stevensons

It is important to Hurst that our school uniform is as sustainable as possible.

Our school uniform is provided by Stevensons who have the following sustainability standards:

All recycled fabrics are Global Recycled Standard (GRS) certified.

Fabrics are 100% recycled polyester. The raw material comes from water bottles from which the yarn is created and then knitted into polyester fabric.

At Stevensons, we support numerous charities, but we are particularly significant contributors to the Christadelphian Jewish Clothing Relief who assist individuals in need due to financial hardship. Sustainability PlayerLayer



The Hurst Sports Kit is created by Player Layer. Their design approach is to create simple, durable, multifunctional sports kit which can be customised and which will last.

Our Hurst Playerlayer Core Sports Kit, which will be stocked in our Uniform Shop, is almost all made from recycled polyester. The exceptions are bags, socks and some of the trim details (e.g. zips, pullers and silicone embellishments).

Player Layer have created sports kit in innovative sustainable ways from materials such as recycled plastic, coffee beans, bamboo charcoal and organic cotton.

Recycled Plastic

“We take old water bottles and chop them into tiny pieces which can be used as the basic ingredient for our yarns, this is then spun into fabric...”

“Our latest innovation in Recycled materials is a 100% recycled polyester, 100% water proof outerwear fabric.”

Organic Cotton

“Many of us don’t realise that often, what we wear started life in the soil. Cotton is grown in a field, the fluffy fibre is picked and then spun into thread. Once woven into material it is light, breathable, easy to work with and easy to wear.

There are various sustainable cottons available, but, if you want to be sure what you are buying is grown in a truly sustainable way, certified organic cotton is the best option. Organic is the only system which eliminates highly toxic substances from the environment and instead works holistically, for the long-term benefit of people and the planet.

We use Organic Cotton in our range of Hoodies, Sweatshirts and Tee Shirts. There is always a place for cotton in the athletes kit bag, but let’s make it organic... One Earth, One Team, Belong...”
